## **Hi-Two Hi-Tech to Bill for Medicare Secondary Payer** **Coming Soon!**

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You can no longer use FISS to process Medicare Secondary Payer (MSP) claims. You must submit these claims on paper (with a waiver) or other electronic means, like the Hi-Tech **Resident Accounting System**.

Under **Billing > Medicare A > Select Bills**, you will be able to select  **MSP** to bill these claims.

## **Hi-Three Change Rates before EOM is Complete** **Coming Soon!**





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Before EOM is complete, you can post room charges through end of month, set up new month census, and change rates for Medicaid, Medicare, and/or Ancillary.

## **Hi-Four Reminder: MIHMS for MaineCare Providers** **Coming Soon!**

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The State of Maine has set August 1, 2010 as the implementation date for the *Maine Integrated Health Management Solutions* (MIHMS) for Medicaid billing. To meet this deadline, Hi-Tech will issue an update to your system in May. This Release will provide the programs you need to send test claims to MIHMS.

-  In June we will offer workshops and Webinars that outline testing procedures.
-  In late June you can begin sending test claims to receive approval before August 1.
-  Once approved, you can prepare to send “live” claims beginning with dates of service 08/01/2010.
-  For Nursing and Residential Care clients who will only submit once a month:  
You can submit claims for discharged residents throughout August and verify that these claims are paid correctly. This will allow you, the State and Hi-Tech to resolve possible issues before you submit the entire batch of August claims in September.

MaineCare billing through MIHMS will require communication and coordination between your Clinical and Resident Accounting staffs. This will ensure that MDS records are completed on time so that RUG scores are available to the Resident Accounting System. In May and June, Hi-Tech will present Webinars on this topic.

We strongly recommend that Maine **MDS Coordinators** attend one of the following Webinars to learn more about how MDS records will be used for billing through MIHMS.

## **Hi-Five Replace Paper MARs/TARs with IMAR**

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Improve your medication administration process with the **IMAR** Electronic Medication Administration System.

-  Know immediately which meds are due and those that are about to be late.
-  Scan medication barcodes as you administer meds to immediately update the resident’s MAR.
-  When you add new orders, check for drug allergies and adverse interactions with the resident’s other medications.
-  Interface to the pharmacy to order and re-order meds.
-  Check in orders quickly and easily by scanning the barcode attached to the order.
