



This Hi-Tech Hi-Five reviews some of the changes provided by Release 10.05. After you install this update, review additional details in the Release 10.05 Update Memo. On the Hi-Tech menu select **Update Memo** and then System Update Release 10.05.

Hi-One **Edit Medical Records Provides New Face Sheet Options**

Under **Admission Procedures > Edit Medical Record > Allergies/Adv Dir/Other** you can now select Do not hospitalize and Organ donor (see below):

Hi-Two **Resident Accounting: You can now Select MSP Billing**


Under **Resident Accounting > Billing > Medicare A > Select Bills** you can now select MSP Billing. The program will no longer use code 74 logic for No Pay Bills. Instead, it will use the Medicare Span Dates for code 70 for No Pay Bills, if included in the Stay Table.

Important: Verify that the description for insurance 4 is Medicare A, not MCR A or other description. Verify this through **Libraries > Face Sheet > Insurance**.

In the Fall of 2009, when we released our new Care Plan design, we renamed Residential Care *Service Plan* to *Care Plan*. At our clients' requests, we have changed the name back to *Service Plan*.

Hi-Four Resident Trust Provides New Check Features

Trust Transactions > Process Trust Checks > Enter Trust Checks:

- Will allow multiple item numbers to be paid to the same vendor.
- The **Service Date** will default to the date for the previous line item.
- You can enter a **Comment** for each line item.

Hi-Five Therapy Systems Provide New Programs

Release 10.05 provides many changes to our Therapy programs, which are described on two full pages of the update memo. The highlights are listed below

Rehab Therapy > Pre-Assessment/Stay Data is a new menu with three choices:

⇒ Rehab Therapy	Daily Procedures	Edit Pre-Assessment Data
Respiratory Therapy	Reporting	Edit Medicare B Data
Record Therapist Time	⇒ Pre-Assessment/Stay Data	Print Medicare B Data

Select **Edit Medicare B Data** to edit records of non-skilled residents who have Part B coverage for therapies (see more details in the Update Memo). You can now **Print Medicare B Data**.

Respiratory Therapy > Daily Procedures > Edit Procedures is a new program that makes it easier to edit procedures that have already been recorded.

Select the resident and [Enter] through the **Start Date** to display recorded procedures.

Select the procedure and edit the information on the screens that display. Record the changes.
